During my 12 years as a consultant in Japan, I had opportunity to go have business trips in other countries in Asia such as Hong Kong, and comparing the business people I met overseas, I realised that Japanese people have more potential to offer. Japanese people are extremely modest, regardless of having equal or better business skills compared to other nationalities in Asia, but it seemed to me that they sometimes miss great business chances because of being too modest. I therefore decided to start a business based on my feeling that "I want to help Japanese people to have more confidence - 'Japan Be Ambitious' " and to help them focus on creating better careers for themselves.

Thanks to the two-stage preparation of the experts, who had English examples and accurately answered my questions, I was able to complete the documents in a short time!
