Regardless of his or her age, starting up a company at the right moment of life is the most important thing.

"Some people say, "If you are starting up a business, why didn't you start it earlier?" That is true, but there is always a right moment for things. You have to make your business plan and be financially ready. Also you have to think in relationship to your family. In my case, everything came together when I was 50. Age is not the most important element. Rather it is a critical point if you can make decision at the right moment.

In my case, as I made proposal to many companies about the management system of business process, I learnt what type of problems companies face in what type of situations. The insight of corporate circumstances became driving force of my business plan. Although each work optimization is successful in many companies, they don't have management system to control and make whole business efficient. I am planning to produce and provide application software to solve the problem.

Since I didn't know anything about starting up a business, I went to Tokyo One-Stop Business Establishment Center to ask for help.

I started to create our business plan myself in Fall of 2018. On December of the same year, I visited Tokyo Startup Station to learn more about starting up business including venture capitals and available subsidies. That is where I learnt about Tokyo One-Stop Business Establishment Center (TOSBEC).

The encounter with many entrepreneurs in his work made him want to start his own business. On 2012, he left the company, and worked in two companies associated with system integrator business. In Fall of 2018, he decided to start his own business. On 2019 February, he established Tech-Dab K.K.

As I was making my business plan, I had to go through governmental procedures to set up a company. Although I didn't have good knowledge of the incorporating process, I still didn't want to spend too much time for governmental process. So, I visited TOSBEC at the end of the year.

If you are in short of time to set up a company, One Stop Center is one of the best solution you have.

At the reception desk of TOSBEC, they handed me a pamphlet. The pamphlet was helpful to grasp the basic flow of setting up a company. Inside the room, different booth for different procedures were lined up in order. I was moved to hear you can do a whole company set—up process only in this center. For incorporation of company, they gave me a model document which I could customize and use it for myself. They said, "the creation of the incorporation document can be followed up by e-mails." Whole arrangement was well organized for registering company by yourself. If you are in short of time for setting up your business, I definitely recommend the use of TOSBEC.



Quick advice

At first, many people don't have knowledge about starting up companies at all. If you don't understand what the experts in the center says, I recommend you to talk to the staff members at the reception for support.
